- II. Consortium Updates
 - a. AEBG Director Position
 - Valentina reported that 1st round interviews occurred earlier in the week, but the committee was unable to reach consensus on which candidates to send to the next round. Therefore the District's minimum was not satisfied
 - 1. Position will be re-flown in the spring, could be as early as February.
 - 2. Valentina will reach out to the Executive Committee via email to request EC participation on the next hiring committee.

 - i. Valentina discussed the letter she received from CCAE as well as summarized her response.

- ii. One-Time Expenditures
 - 1. Since purchase of modular buildings for the Anaheim Campus is not architecturally feasible, we have a large amount of our 2015-16 allocation left to spend.
 - 2. The EC charged WGs to come up with one-time expenditures that can easily be voted on and then purchased. WGs have until the Feb EC Meeting to propose amendments to the current budget. Brainstorming ideas included:

 - c. Project Management Professional Expert Support for Marketing/Website
 - d. Expansion of AEBG Offices

 - 1. Mental health workshops conducted at local schools

 - 2. Hired 2nd Computer Instructor to join Asher Baca at the One Stop. Will offer 4 courses in Winter term

 - Hiring dates are staggered two are present at the EC Meeting. The third will begin in January
 - 2. Will re-fly position to hire a fourth
 - iii. December \$kills to Pay the Bill\$ Workshops
 - First two weeks of December at Gilbert. El Camino was cancelled after first week due to low attendance
 - iv. Strong Workforce Initiative
 - Aligning SCE's proposal with NOCRC's Workforce Development & Career Pathways strategy
