North Orange County ROP career education programs are chosen for their real-world relevance and earnings potential. Which in-demand career pathway will you choose?

- » Advanced Dental Assistant (RDA Preparation): Career-focused curriculum includes 200+ hours covering critical topics like radiographic procedures, sterilization and infection control, coronal polish, pit and fissure sealant, and emergency procedures. After Completion, students are prepared and eligible to sit for the Registered Dental Assistant Exam with 200+ hours of verifiable work experience.
- » Medical Assistant*(Clinical and Administrative):
 Workforce-ready instruction covers in-demand proficiencies
 like diagnostic procedures, lab skills, clinical terminology,
 and medical office skills. The program consists of 23 weeks
 with a total of 276 hours in theory and clinical practicum
 with an additional 5 weeks (120 160 hours) of internship.
 Opportunities for Medical Assistants are increasing by 29%
 annually!
- » Medical Terminology: Fast, focused courses pack the fundamentals aimed at helping learners develop a foundational understanding of medical vocabulary and the terminology of body systems
- » Nurse Assistant*, Long-Term Care (CNA Preparation): Students will jump into a 13-week program (178 hours) that will provide the expertise training in basic nursing care, emergency procedures, communication, and how to work effectively as a member of a health care team. Students perform 100+ hours of hands-on clinical work.
- » Acute Care CNA: Extended Certificate* The North Orange County ROP Acute Care CNA course is designed as an extension to equip a Certified Nurse Assistant with the necessary basic skills of the CNA in the acute care setting.
- » Vocational Nursing*: Get the next-level knowledge you need to launch a high-energy nursing career, Vocational Nursing Program is designed to equip adult students with the necessary knowledge and skills to become a Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN) in California through 1000 hours of clinical experience & 600 hours of theory.

North Orange County ROP offerings are evaluated and fine-tuned on a consistent basis, with the input of regional employers and business leaders. This ensures that your skills are up-to-date and job-ready.
